Accent Glazing is a unique finish to cabinetry that adds a beautifully artistic touch. It is hand applied, and wiped off, by skilled craftsmen to add depth and to accentuate the door profile.

When accent glaze is applied to Driftwood stain it may change the variations of the door color, giving it a lower level of the "milkiness" look than a door with no accent glaze. The tan colors, in some wood species, may be more prominent in a glazed door versus an unglazed door.

The antique characteristic that is associated with glazing adds darker tones to the profiles and edges of a door. This changes the appearance of doors when compared to doors that have not been glazed.

We expect designers and dealers to show their customers a sample door in the style, finish, and wood species that they are purchasing for their home.
